

It is sometimes a challenging reading, but definitely worth reading till the very last chapter, which differs from others significantly. If someone prefers simple, American narration of short and plain sentences, he or she

might feel overwhelmed by the authors' style. One star I took away because of uneven distribution of theory and practice among the chapters. I regretted the fact that the chapter 'Regulation and Development', which was the most interesting to me, lacked that practical approach of the chapter 'Network Issues'. Generally, I would recommend this book to anyone who really cares what does 'good regulation' actually mean - provided that this person has plenty of time to read.
