

Customer Reviews

I have the original 1992 hardcover edition of this title, as published by Prentice Hall. The pages of this 1998 paperback edition issued by Oklahoma University Press are smaller, which probably reduces readability. Other than that, I don't know what, if any, changes were made in this edition. On the assumption that they were few, what follows are my comments (slightly revised) concerning the 1992 edition. This is a good basic reference on the exploration of North America. It is not really suited for reading cover to cover (although I did that), but it would be a fine addition to most

all-purpose libraries, especially high school and college libraries. (The 1992 hardcover, larger-format edition would be preferable for library use.) Aside from the prefatory texts for the book as a whole and for each part of the book, the basic format consists of two-page spreads, each of which is devoted to a particular episode of the European exploration of the regions of North America that now comprise the United States and Canada. (De facto and without explanation, the book excludes Mexico from North America.) For example, the first three spreads in the book present the voyage of John Cabot (1497), Ponce de Leà n's and other early Spanish expeditions to Florida (1513-1526), and the voyage of Verrazano up the east coast of present-day United States (1524).
