

To give full disclosure, I was given a free copy of this book in return for an honest review. Also, I have not read the first two book in this series, I am familiar with this author from his Adventures of Damian Stockwell series. I started reading the Damian Stockwell series because I am a fan of pulp

writing and I stuck around for the author's penchant for being able to mix serious adventure with humor and satire. There is a lot of that same style here in the Pursuit of the Apocalypse. Lots of action, serious danger, but then toungue in cheek humor and a satirical look at our modern society through the eyes of the Apocalypse. I know that's a common trope dating all the way back to George Romero's Day of the Dead, but I think I can safely say you won't find the writing or the humor or the pointed barbs at our current society derivative in any way. It also reminds me a bit of Stephen King's Dark Tower books, only funny on purpose. The novel follows the adventures of a character named The Librarian who is following a white suited bounty hunter who has captured his wife. Not having read the previous two books, I thought I would be at a disadvantage jumping in with Book 3. But a lot of the book deals with the reputation the Librarian has gained from his previous exploits and how the characters throughout the book reconcile their real life meetings with him versus the reputation he has. So this conceit in the book actually works to a late-coming reader's benefit because the reader is experiencing, as the story goes on, the same experiences the books characters are, vis a vis reputation versus reality. The side characters are great. The old woman who lives with three bears (super smart or not? you must be uneducated about bears!
