

needs to remove this book from kindle. This edition practically yells at us in its description, "This Ebook Features Dynamic Links for Ease of Navigation" but there are NOT dynamic links. This is a huge collection of the works of Frederick Douglass and I had been so looking forward to start reading them right away, but I couldn't navigate at all. When you first open the book, it goes right to an introduction, and I wanted to get right into the meat of it so went to "Go to ..." so that I could go to the Table of Contents and leap to whichever work I wanted at that moment - but the go-to options did not include the table of contents. So I did a "search this book" for the table of contents, and it told me that this book had not yet been indexed so there was no table of contents to go to. The list of works and chapters in the description of this book in the kindle store is what I assumed would be at the front of this book, but instead the book has a messy area that I assume is suppose to be the table of contents, and there are no links. I returned the book probably within 20 minutes of buying it because a collection this big cannot be navigated without an expenditure of a lot of energy and guesswork. It just feels like completely false advertising on the part of the person who put this collection together - and judging by the date of publication, they've had way over two years to get it right. If they're having problems with formatting to kindle, they need to remove their loud yells about the dynamic links, which simply don't exist. Oh and as a side note - I really should have listened to myself before buying this when it felt really odd that the title would be in all caps, and the "Dynamic Links" plug had every first letter capitalized.
